This link is also registered in a relational database (ORACLE or MS-SQL Server) and serves as a reference to the new actual storage location. The email itself is compressed and stored on the designated storage media, which in turn saves additional storage space.

Emails are instantly reduced to 2-5 kilobytes.

The Challenge

Mobile email users required a flexible archiving solution. Nowadays travel is a necessity in business, a workforce must adapt to out of office management. The continuous specification improvements to laptops and PDA's improve the chance of valuable work being produced whilst 'on the move' but proficient personal email and file management then becomes a requirement. With email now being the primary form of communication internally and externally, organising mailboxes requires a competent solution.

Many users today combine their use of email between an office PC and portable laptop. One consequence of this, which was a challenge for the LAF, is that users store their archived PST folders on a laptop to work from home. Problems developed when their hard drive failed and they lost the archive, or when the IT administrator had to manually move the archive to the users' next laptop; a time consuming process. The archive store location causes users more inconveniences than are necessary. Having different mailboxes being accessible on different workstations creates an incoherent system; therefore relocating the archive to a centralised store is the logical solution.
